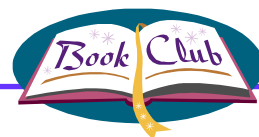
Circle of Stitchers

Book Club

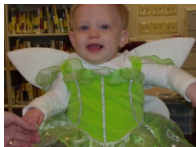


Joint book club between the Plum Library and the Plum Senior Center.
