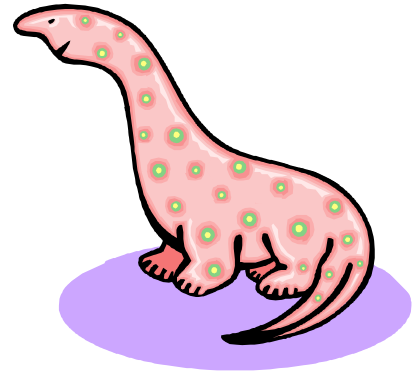

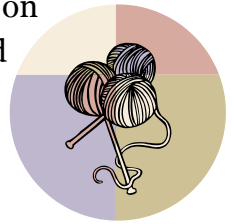
Ceramics for Kids
